Professional Lands Management Certification Program (PLMCP)

Level I – Post-Secondary Training



Kanawayihetaytan Askiy Certificate

21 credits (7 courses) - hybrid delivery Can typically be completed in 1–2 years, full-time or part-time Registration closed for next intake



Professional Lands Management Certification Program (PLMCP) Level I

18 credits (6 courses) - hybrid delivery

Typically completed in 1 year

Registration deadline for next intake: April 30, 2025



Professional Indigenous Lands Management Certificate

18 credits (6 courses) - online delivery

Typically completed within 1 year, with an option to complete it intensively over one summer (in-person) + an online fall semester

Registration deadline for next intake: July 31, 2025

Typically completed within 2 years, as UQAT offers one course per semester Registration deadline for next intake: June 1, 2025





PLMCP

Level II – Technical Training

Level II is the technical component that provides a **deeper practical understanding of land** and related subjects and applications in the effective and efficient management of reserve lands.

After successfully completing the requirements of Level I and Level II, graduates will have earned their national certification as a land manager.




